## REMINDERS

**RBC 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Tours** – Parents must come to the Business Office and sign the students out and back in. Students must wear their SJS uniforms.

**Parent Teachers Conferences** - Parents will be assigned a day and time for conferences. Progress Reports must be signed and return on Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>.

**St. Barnabus Fire Demonstration** – All 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students are to wear their gym clothes on this day.

**Harvest Dinner** – The parking lot will be closed for 5:30 and 7:30 Masses. Cars may not be brought on to the campus until after 8:00 PM as per Monsignor's instructions.

**Pictures** – Students may wear either their uniforms or dress up clothes for the picture taking session. Jeans, sneakers, or sweats may not be worn. This is not a dress down day. Please be sure that your child has their picture selection envelope and check on the day of the picture taking session.

**Red Ribbon Dress Down** – Students may dress down (jeans, sweats, sneakers permissible) but must wear something dominantly red. \$1 donation is asked.

**Bake Sale/Dress Down** – In the event of a fund raiser whereby a \$1 donation is asked, the chair of the event or, in the case of a student initiated bake sale, a parent must oversee the counting of money and supervise the bake sale.

**Halloween** – Students in grades K-5 may wear costumes to school. No masks or accessories are to be brought to school. Costumes should not be too hot or cumbersome that school work would be prohibitive. Students in grades 6-8 may dress down. Halloween hair dye or face painting is not permitted in grades 6-8.

**Halloween Parade** – K-3 – Students will proceed out the front doors to Broad Street, visit the rectory and convent, and return to the building through the front or Drummond doors.
