The first project of the Foundation will be the Hôpital Sacré Coeur and Kay Ang (Angel House) Orphanage in Haiti. With the help of St. James Elementary School families, we are coordinating a clothing, shoe and school supply drive for this amazing organization.

Our goal is to collect gently used summer clothes, shoes and school supplies including backpacks, crayons, etc. to be shipped to Haiti in December. Clothes can be kids and adults. Monetary donations are also welcomed.

Collection bins will be located in the St. James Elementary School lobby on Monday, June 13th through Thursday, June 16th. Also, on Thursday, June 16th, Barnes & Noble in Holmdel has generously offered to allow collections to take place as well. St. James families will be onsite throughout the day to collect items both large and small.

Donations that are too large for children to carry to school should be brought to Barnes & Noble, and volunteers will be available to help transfer to our onsite vehicles. Or arrangements may be made to deliver the donations directly to our storage facility at a mutually convenient time.
