WHEREAS, the Catholic schools in the State of New Jersey have educated millions of New Jerseyans in preparation for their responsibilities as residents of this State and as members of society; and

WHEREAS, the more than 295 Catholic schools in the State currently provide more than 125,000 students with an education that emphasizes the formation of moral values and a commitment to community service; and

WHEREAS, the welfare of the State requires that this and future generations of school-age children be assured ample opportunity to develop their intellectual capacities to the fullest; and

WHEREAS, this year's theme of "Catholic Schools: Faith. Academics. Service." recognizes the contribution of Catholic Schools to New Jersey's educational system;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, do hereby proclaim:
